

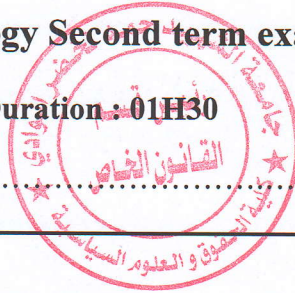

01	Definition of Insurance Law	01	Are negotiable instruments (written documents) representing a monetary right payable either on demand (upon presentation) or after a short or long period. By commercial custom, they are accepted as a means of payment.
02	عقد التأمين	02	(محرر) مكتوب وفق أوضاع شكلية استقر عليها الغرف التجاري، وهو مكون من ثلاثة أطراف، وفيها أمر صادر من صاحب الشيك وهو الساحب إلى طرف آخر مسحوب عليه وهو - في هذه الحالة - البنك، وذلك بأن يدفع البنك مبلغاً من المال للطرف الثالث وهو المستفيد، ويسمى أيضاً حامله أو "الأمره" وذلك عند الاطلاع، أي بمجرد تقديم الشيك.

04	Cheque	04	Particularly under Algerian legislation in accordance with Ordinance No. 95-07 as amended and supplemented by Law No. 06-04, is defined as a contract whereby the insurer undertakes to cover a risk (whether relating to persons or damages) in exchange for a financial premium
